Meritorious Service Honorees

The New Jersey PTA Meritorious Service Award is bestowed upon an individual who had a lead role in an outstanding, successful endeavor contributing to the welfare of New Jersey’s children.

The honor is presented with the approval of a local PTA/PTSA/SEPTA, a County Council or the New Jersey PTA. The source of funds must be approved by the PTA/PTSA making the presentation.

This award recognizes an individual that has given their time and talent in a specific activity, ongoing program or the development of a new project that promotes advocacy for children.
